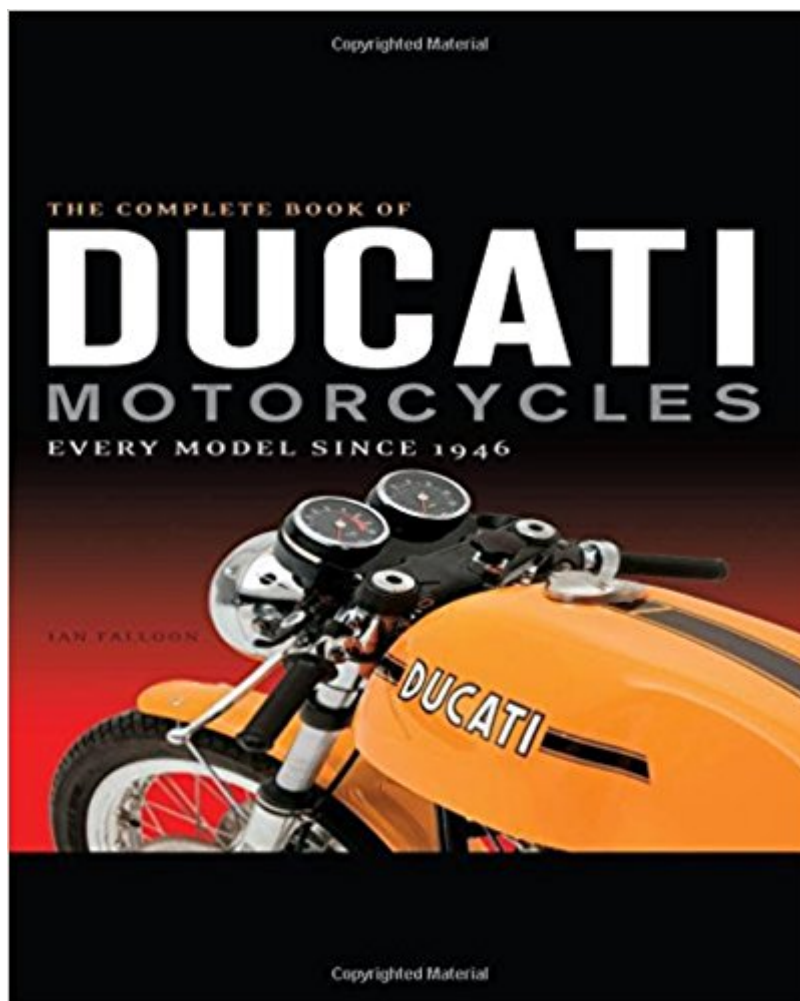




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The Complete Book Of Ducati Motorcycles: Every Model Since 1946
