

I fell in love with this series because it was an RH and how wonderful CL writes about their budding relationships, but after 11 books I'm in the mood for more heat and action with her guys and I'm scared I'm never going to get that. I would love to see a time jump, I don't need or want to read book after book at such a snails pace. It's sad because I absolutely love Sang and her guys A LOT but all this waiting and what's gonna happen are making me frustrated. That being said I will still continue to read this series because it's become a mission which I need to see to completion, frustrations or not.

If you've made it this far into the series already, then you have an idea of what to expect from the writing and the story line. However, this book was a little different as it had dual POV's- Sang and Dr. Sean Green. It was a great change to the writing style allowing us readers to get a more in-depth view of some of the characters we have fallen in love with over the years. This book gave us what we have all been waiting for from the beginning I think, Sang away from her family for good, hopefully. You also get to see Sang express her feelings more in a way that allows each person to know exactly what she is feeling. I think this will help everyone so much in the future. We get a preview into what the next book may have to offer and it is a major cliffhanger. I hope we will not have to wait long for the book to know what happens, but no matter the time length, I know I will be anxiously waiting for its release.

As always with this author, just when you think you know how things are going to go she switches

direction and off you go in another direction. When you write this many books in a series you have to keep the story line interesting and fun and she does this every time. This one, for me, was a bit of a let down for me. There was not much action and Sang was not the strong heroine we have come to know and love. This time the guys have to step up. The other problem is that as the relationships develop the author has to give Sang with each of the guys and because there are so many of them it tends to slow the story itself down as they all have their bit of time with her. By the end it feels a bit unresolved to me as I didn't feel we got to the bottom of the motives of the new "family members" so I am assuming that while they appear to be sorted at the end of the book that they will be coming back at sometime in the future to even things out. I only gave it three stars simply because a lot of the sessions with each of the boys felt more and more like filler rather than actually pushing the story line along.

First, let me say that I don't review books. I read so many books so quickly, that it just isn't possible. This book series is the exception. I can't keep my thoughts to myself. This is my favorite series of all time. I can't get enough of it! I read this book as soon as it appeared in my kindle. After reading the series several times I still think it is amazing.
