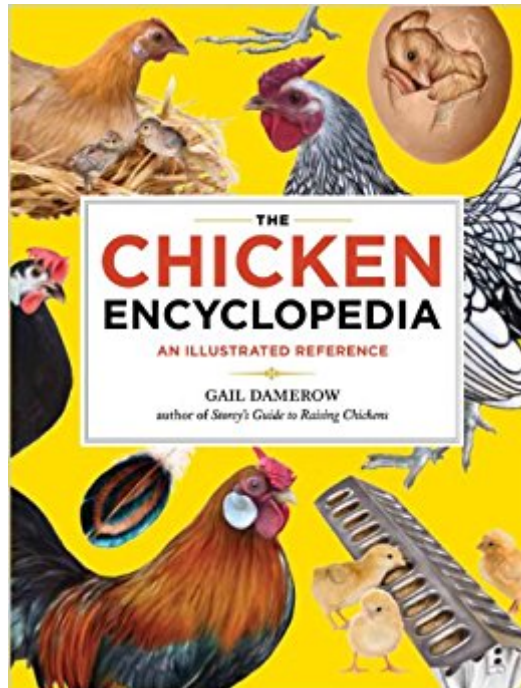




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The Chicken Encyclopedia: An Illustrated Reference

Damerow is a regular contributor to Backyard Poultry, Countryside, and Rural Heritage magazines. She lives in Tennessee with her husband, where they operate a family farm with poultry and dairy goats, a sizable garden, and a small orchard.

Very good beginner book for chickens. I have found myself reading it from the front cover and am about 3/4 of the way through. Some parts I skip that I am already knowledgeable in. But lots of new info for me. It lacks some detail in a few spots. But gives a good general descriptions of a huge amount of chicken facts.

I have been messing about with other peoples' chickens for two or three years and realized that I didn't know the right questions to ask, let alone the answers. A blog that I hit on by chance was very informative and well written; the author was credited with The Chicken Encyclopedia so I went for it. It has entries that don't concern me but provide interesting background information (and who knows when I might need to know; for example; how to candle eggs?). This book has answered questions that I didn't know to ask as well as those that I was aware of but didn't bother with - and some of them are much more important than I realized. Buy it.

This book has a lot of info and it is useful. It's almost more of a chicken dictionary though. The terms have a very short description rather than any sort of depth to the topic. This was not quite what I was expecting. If I had leafed through it in a bookstore, I would not have purchased...but just a personal opinion based on the sort of reference material I was seeking.

Love this book! Very informative and has helpful illustrations. Charts with varieties of birds and problems are very helpful additions. I've learned a lot and prefer this to googling on many occasions. I recommend everyone who owns chickens, even old pros, to have this book handy.

If you have read Gail Damerow's book Storey's Guide to Raising Chickens, you will find The Chicken Encyclopedia's content to be redundant. That being said, there are nice pictures and diagrams that are very useful, the index is a bit different which may help you find something, and entries are short and sweet. If you only need one chicken book buy Storey's Guide to Raising Chickens after that City Chicks is a terrific choice or H. Ussery's The Small-Scale Poultry Flock if you are going to be mixing your own chicken rations, growing fodder, etc. And Damerow's Chicken Health book is good to have on hand. Pros: Nice illustrations, pictures, diagrams; easy to read charts, relatively compressive entries for most of us Cons: Damerow's other books have much of this content already, not a first chicken book

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
