

I bought this book simply as a reference guide since I was building a copy of a 1952 Telecaster for my brother. I'm a guitarist and luthier and I build a variety of stringed instruments from guitars, to ukuleles, to dulcimers [...]. I'd never built a solid body electric before. I wanted to make sure I was staying true to the '52 external specs as much as possible, while looking into the later years of the guitar for upgrading the "innards" of the project. So in the beginning, my use of the book was limited. However, the more I read, the more I learned about the Tele in general, things I never knew about the father of all electric guitars as it matured. It was actually quite fascinating and well presented. There are plenty of illustrations and photos and the text is very readable. It ended up putting more ideas in my head for building future guitars of the Tele genre. The book is full of accurate and interesting information on all aspects of the Telecaster family. It isn't what I'd call a coffee table book, but is an excellent technical reference and quite interesting in many other aspects. Highly

recommended.

If you're looking to gain knowledge and factual information about the greatest solid body electric guitar ever produced, this is the book you want. Leo Fender got it EXACTLY right with his first attempt when it comes to solid body electric guitars and this book gives you all of the nitty gritty you will need to find the right Telecaster for yourself or just add to your guitar knowledge. I highly recommend this book and I am a fifty year Telecaster player.
