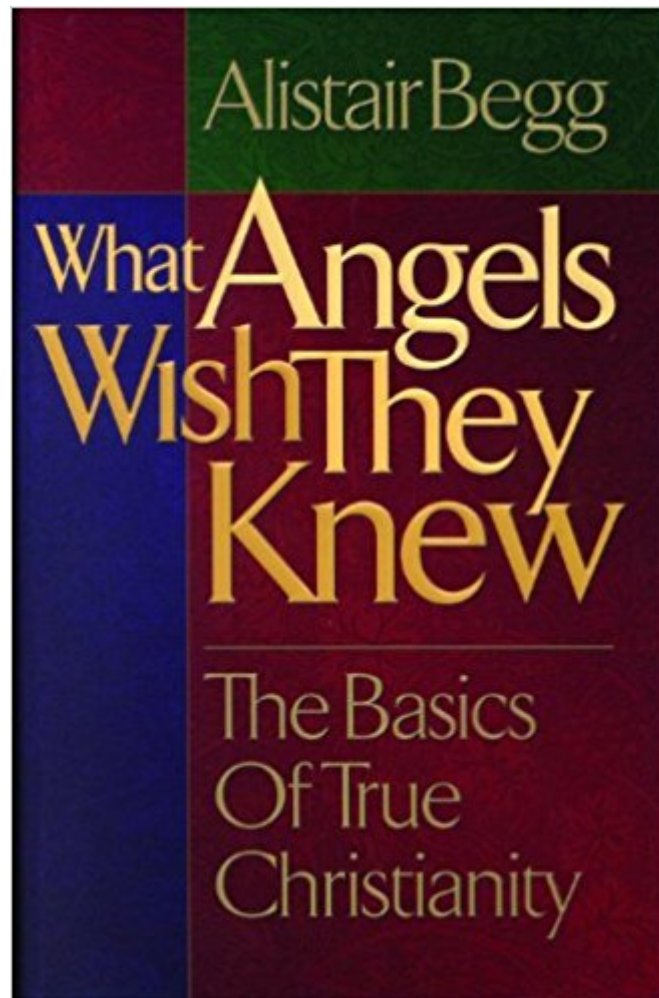

ALISTAIR BEGG (Trent University; London School of Theology; Westminster Seminary) was born in Scotland and spent the first 30 years of life in the United Kingdom. Since September of 1983, he has been the senior pastor at Parkside Church in suburban Cleveland, Ohio. He is the daily speaker on the national radio program Truth For Life which stems from his weekly Bible teaching at Parkside, and is the author of *Made For His Pleasure*, *Lasting Love*, and *What Angels Wish They Knew*. He and his wife, Susan, have three grown children.

A likable and engaging pastor pulls his listeners aside and confidently presses his ideas into their

hearts. Chumminess with God, he says, leaves out an important article of faith--that we will be judged on whether we follow God's laws, in particular The Ten Commandments. We only have one life, here and now, in which to prove our allegiance and devotion to Jesus, so it's important not to be misled by New Age angels who don't understand the vastness of His love. Coming from the school that believes God's power is an infallible and fearsome aspect of Christianity, Begg says we should get in step with this power and stop looking for an easy way out of our sinfulness.
