

I've been curious about different types of gardening for quite some time. A friend of mine (a hardcore vegan) was recently talking about hydroponic gardening, so when I saw this book I thought it would be worth reading. The price was reasonable and I was hoping it would contain the basic information I would need if I wanted to give this particular type of gardening a try. Prior to reading this book (and hearing my friend mention it in passing) the most information I'd received about hydroponic gardening was from random passages in Heinlein science fiction. This book made hydroponics seem less daunting and more like something that was actually possible to set up on my

own. The instructions were clear and the diagrams/pictures were easy to follow. The book DOES address some of the disadvantages of this type of gardening right from the start so you can decide if it's worth your time before you run out and buy supplies. Also, the author offers plenty of troubleshooting advice to help you if you run into problems or need to identify reasons why your fruits/veggies aren't growing the way you hoped. I do plan to try at least the deep water culture system for some herbs or small vegetables. If it works out I will try some of the other systems outlined. I'm not the most DIY type of woman, but with the instructions and pictures provided by the author I think I can manage. Plus, a trip to an Atlanta hydroponics store already showed me that the DIY methods in this book will save me a LOT of money. With that in mind, I recommend this book to anyone ready to try hydroponic gardening without being forced to spend a lot of money.

I'm happy with this book. Plenty of detail for me to start growing virtually any plant anywhere by growing my plants in a nutrient-rich solution, rather than in soil, and under controlled conditions of light, temperature, and humidity. (Hydroponics) Also often called aquaculture. Many people are like me and haven't the space for an outdoor traditional garden, or the conditions are not right for outdoor gardening. (To hot/cold or to dry/wet) I used this book to start my garden in my spare room and it's a pleasure tending my plants each day. All in all a well written guide with easy to understand how-to info. I would recommend this book to those thinking of hydroponic gardening.

This book sucks, not professionally written, didn't learn anything, terrible quality of pictures didn't even know what I was looking at. Waste of time and money.

Oh, oh. I goofed. Please read the review from lulu for Hydroponic Gardening. I was looking at the wrong book. Hydroponic Fertilizing also useful! It has good information on elements needed by plants and how to tell what they need by looking at the plant. It is somewhat simplistic and helpful to get your feet wet. You still need to know how to build the system! And the reason I confused the reviews. You also need this book!

Less technical than I'd hoped. It exposes the reader to the different methods of hydroponic gardening, but does not cover the specifics of how each should be applied to strawberries as the name would imply. I was seeking more data for my gravity pipe system, pump run times, recommended slopes or speed of water/fertilizer, etc. This book will give you a very basic overview of hydroponics, but far from "complete" as the name suggests.

A bit short, more pictures would have been a nice feature. I liked the topics, the price was right .

This book is a good intro to Hydroponics which is what I wanted. As I learn more, I will probably get me a small set up and learn about hydroponics in the now. Hopefully I will be able to use it for salad vegetables.

This book, "Complete Hydroponic Gardening.....," was a great disappointment. It is poorly written, in my view, but there are some interesting bits of facts and general information. I would not recommend this publication, however, particularly as there is quite a bit of free information on the 'Net covering much the same topics about hydroponics and some well-done videos available on YouTube on the subject.
