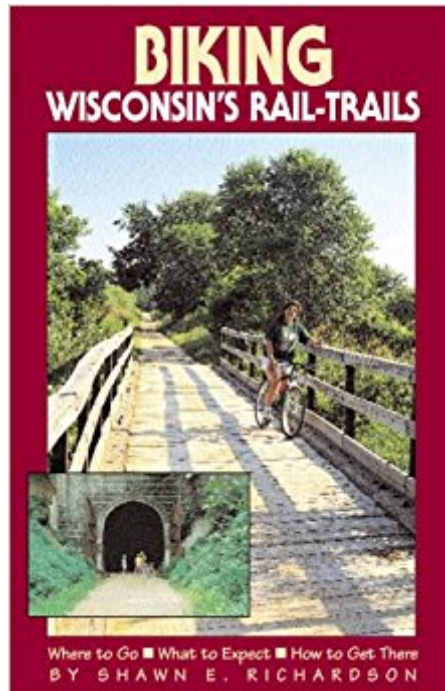

Richardson provides information about the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and their involvement with Wisconsin's rail-trails. If you live in Wisconsin, or plan to visit Wisconsin, this book is a must for any cyclist!
