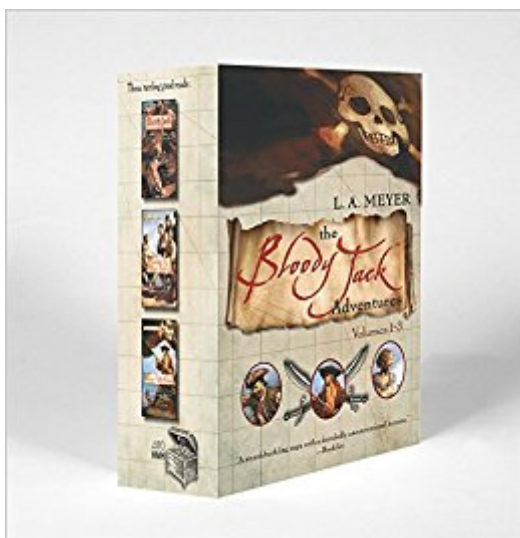


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The Bloody Jack Adventures Boxed Set: Volumes 1-3
