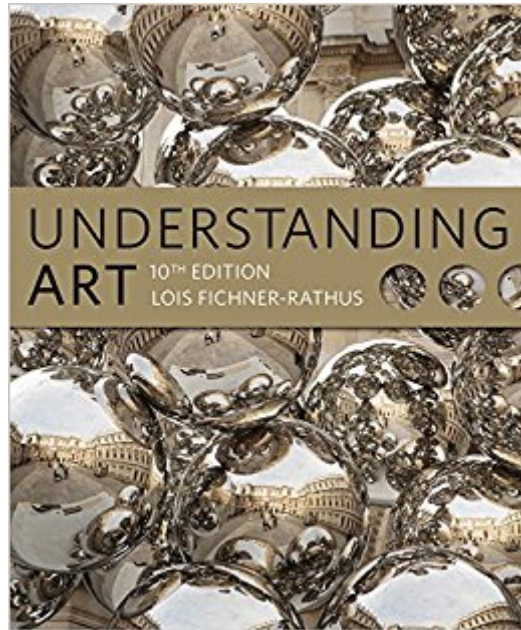

It was very useful.

The book is good but the fact that it says "WITH CD" and then underneath it says "THERE IS NO CD" is kind of annoying especially since I purchased it thinking there was a CD. I think should penalize things like this as it is being advertised to buyers that there is a CD-ROM inside your package, when in reality there isn't and I feel like I was tricked into purchasing an item for something that doesn't actually come with it. Other than that issue the book is in good condition and appears to be fine. But when it comes down to it I wouldn't repurchase from the seller.
