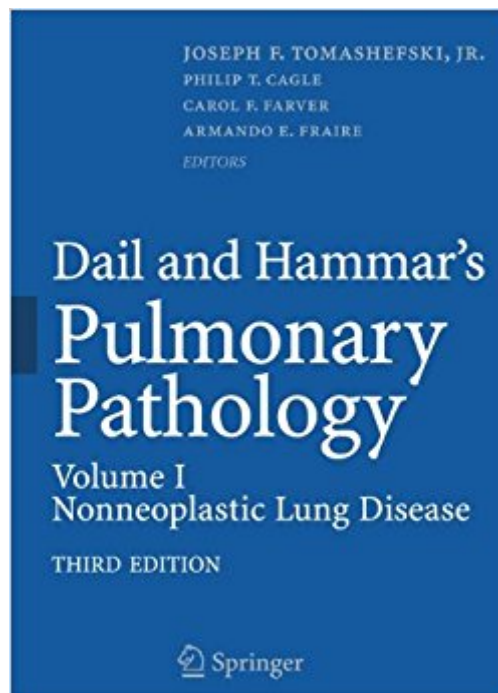




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Dail And Hammar's Pulmonary Pathology, Volume 1: Nonneoplastic Lung Disease
