

I have traded penny stocks before. I downloaded the kindle version of this book to see if there was anything that could help me get back into it. I thought it would discuss the process from start to

finish for anyone wanting to learn about how to do it or anyone wanting to get back into it, like me. It has been a while so a refresher never hurts. One thing I noticed that this book did not discuss is risk management, which is a basic idea, but may be a foreign language to a new person who has never traded anything before. I was always told that when you first begin trading, start with penny stocks to avoid a big loss risk. I was also told that you should never invest all your money in one place. Nowhere in this book does it go into this, which I truly believe that anyone new to stocks needs to know. There were just some lacking things in this book. I am not saying it is a horrible book by no means, but to say this is a quick start guide for beginners, I just don't think it shares enough to really give the beginner the knowledge they should really know before beginning.

I was interested in learning about more about penny stocks as my son began to question me about it, so I downloaded the e book version of this book. I thought this book provided basic definitions and information about stocks, but was not a complete guide. The author explained some of the stock vocabulary very well and provided some useful tips. In addition, the book was easy to follow, unlike many other guides out there. It starts off simple and gradually builds into more complex topics. Another bonus is that it is a quick read. It is not terribly long or boring. I believe this guide will help you familiarize yourself with some stock terms, but I would use this along with other books/resources to further expand your education on stocks and begin investing. Not bad for a quick start guide and overall I am glad I read the book. It provided good, basic information on the stock market and penny stocks. If you are new to the world of investing, I would definitely recommend this book. Note: I received this product at a discounted price in exchange for my unbiased review. With an academic background in Physics and then Computer Science, I thought 17 years ago that as an aside I acquired a solid analytical background, skills, and learning-ability to do well Trading stocks outside of my full time job as a Software Engineer..Little did I know how challenging trading stocks can be..17 years later, and after having traded in many different methods including Penny Stocks - some as low as 12 Cents/share -my real life experience Trading stocks makes me a little critical of what's in this book and more importantly of what's missing from it. Where do I start?1. Nowhere in the book do they discuss proper Risk Management - WOW! - No discussion about Stop Loss and how to set it up.2. The suggestion to paper-trade like as if it will prepare you for real trading is unrealistic. It may help familiarize you with terms and the vibe of the market, but thinking you will know how to trade better after paper-trading is like thinking that you are a good shooter by

shooting empty cans at a distance whereas in real life warfare there are people shooting back at you.3. The Chapter on Technical Analysis covers the basic terms but has NO Charts - not even one to illustrate a term.4. The amount of analysis you are directed to follow in order to find up-and-coming Penny Stock Companies is not applicable to anyone who holds a day job. You will need to spend a few hours once or twice a week probably, to crunch numbers. All that volume of information regarding Fundamental Analysis may border in Analysis Paralysis.5. The Human aspect of Trading is completely absent from the book - our emotions play a huge part in Investing. Losing takes a toll and counter-intuitively winning may make you less cautious with future trades. A chapter on the emotional aspect of trading would have served the book well.6. The book does not list good sources where to get your picks from - I would expect it to at least recommend "Investor's Business Daily" - an incredible daily Newspaper (online too obviously) where in one look you get the best companies that trade at under \$5 with ratings that have proven reliable over time (and a wealth of information regarding trading in general).7. Risk management requires diversification - mentioned in the book - but also correct portioning of your portfolio. Never put more than 5-10% on each position. I would even say that as a 'trader' never use more than 30% of your TOTAL funds. Investors with long time horizon may put more into their investment portfolios with caveats but that's a whole subject in its own right out of the scope here.8. The book notes volume and volatility considerations but should have made it amply clear - Stay Away from low-volume stocks. That brings huge volatility and worse - inability to get out when you want to. The book does provide ample information and will familiarize you with trading terms hence the 3-Star from me, but for actual real-lifetrading you should seek more resources and the Internet is filled with them. The book was offered to me free for my unbiased opinion as shared here, and I accepted the offer because of my interest and experience on the subject and happy I had the chance to share my take on it with potential readers.

Being a recent graduate and working for a non-profit I need help with money on a pretty regular basis. I had read about penny stocks before but was always warned as quickly as you can make money you can also lose it just as quickly, which always made me hesitant to start investing. This book is a helpful starter guide on how to choose and manage penny stocks. It's not too expensive to get started and they are very realistic about investing. Nice guide to start investing

While I think it's a great starter book, it certainly does not make me an expert. I will need to do more reading and research before I start investing.
