

I really loved this book, I found the teaching on Grace profound. I perceived from the tone of the writing that Charles intended it for elementary teaching in the Gospel of Grace but I find that the book will be very powerful for people searching for truth, those who have not yet fully dedicated their lives to Christ and the believer looking to encourage themselves with some very insightful reading. Charles uses simple paraphrasing of deep Christian teaching that makes it easy for somebody to relate to the message that is being relayed. The book also has sufficient depth to keep the practicing Christian spell bound to the teaching and awed by the insights in his delivery. It is evident that Charles had a very innate relationship with God and His word that he is able to deliver it with ease while not losing the intensity of the subject

The material within this book is 5-stars...but I was hoping to get the updated, modern-language version published by Whitaker House that was advertised in the back of their edition of "The Soul Winner", also by Spurgeon. The book I received is in Spurgeon's original composition and is published by readaclassic.com. Normally, I am not a fan of "updated in modern language" editions. But Whitaker House did such an exceptional job of it in "The Soul Winner", and my purpose for acquiring "All Of Grace" was to review it for new Christians in my addictions ministry (facebook: The Least of These: The LOT), that I thought it would be more appropriate as "milk". The contents are great, the book is a little overpriced (no title on the spine), and it did give me an idea of what to expect in the Whitaker House version. And delivered as timely as promised.
