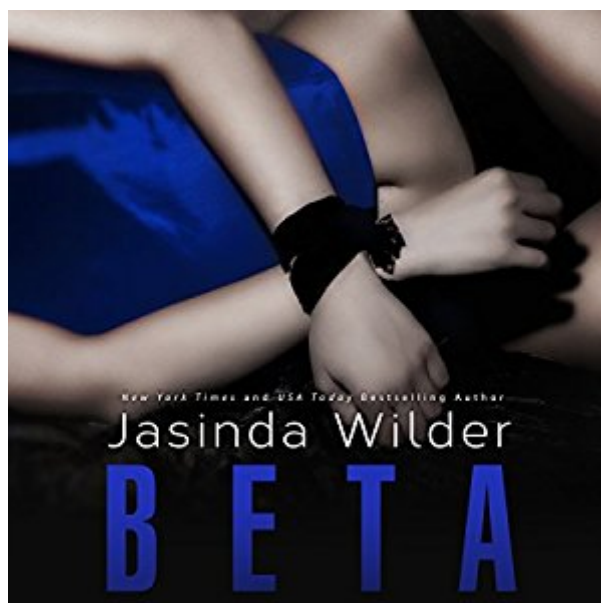

It was fairly quick with the action and the cast of characters were awesome. One of the really good things about this book is, it brings a cause to light that's not always talked about. When people think of the word/action "rape" it's usually where a victim is a woman. In this case, it didn't. It can take any psychopath to be that way. With Roth being an "un-likely" victim so to speak, it shows a vulnerability that may not have been. Yes, here's this strong, brave man, but he suffered at the hands of another. He had to overcome so much. Just as much as she did. I'll be honest and say some of it bothered me, and it can be a trigger for some. Each character has such a strong presence as well. I loved how it ended though. It left it open for the next one to come on through. I would read it again. Warning: If you have triggers set off by violence, sex, and blood, be cautionary if you choose to read it.

The 2 stars is not for the writing as Jasinda Wilder is an accomplished writer but the low star rating is for the ending. An ending that has been left open and the author is not sure if she will write another book! She talks about leaving the story as is, for the integrity of the story which I find as just a weak excuse. The book could have been wrapped up easily if she felt that this was the way to keep the integrity of the characters and story and there was no more for these characters. I understand how a story can write itself and lead you through an unexpected journey, that's not what I'm really disappointed in, this to me seems like the author is burnt out and has no real foreseeable direction for this series. Again an easy fix just end it now but DON'T leave your loyal fans hanging, that's just plain rude.
