This is a good presentation of varying views evangelicals take on the reality, nature, & duration of hell. If you don't understand how someone can believe scripture to be true AND be a universalist or annihilationist, this book will be enlightening. It's an accessible read that accomplishes its objective; to state the case for a few diverse views. If you are already familiar with the positions Christians take on this issue, this book is unlikely to offer new insights. I was disappointed that so little attention was given by any of the contributors on the historical development of the doctrine of hell. This is, in my opinion, a significant shortcoming of the volume.

GREAT is an understatement. Having only been exposed to the traditional camp, it was great to see the other positions with respective scriptural support. Intellectually the purgatory view makes a ton of sense but the scriptural backing wasn't there IMO. The strongest scriptural basis seemed to be annihilationism or universalism. My only complaint would be the traditional view synopsis. Either the support is weak in the scriptures or Denny Burk did an absolutely TERRIBLE job supporting a strong position.

Excellent presentation of various arguments and responses. Beck's arguments seemed noticeably weak. He made many statements without back up evidence. E.g., the word for "forever" in Matt 25 he claims does definitely mean forever. There is good evidence that this is not the case but without evidence he merely states that this is what it means (p28). I'll give more detailed comments when I complete reading the book. This is a very good addition to the 1996 edition which had other contributors.

Good read if 1) you like deep stuff, and 2) you have always wondered about the hell gospel.

Very interesting and readable book about four views on hell. I found it encouraging to read the book and find that there are others that, like myself, do not believe that God would torture people for eternity. All four views on hell are well argued by their proponents and the book is very readable.
