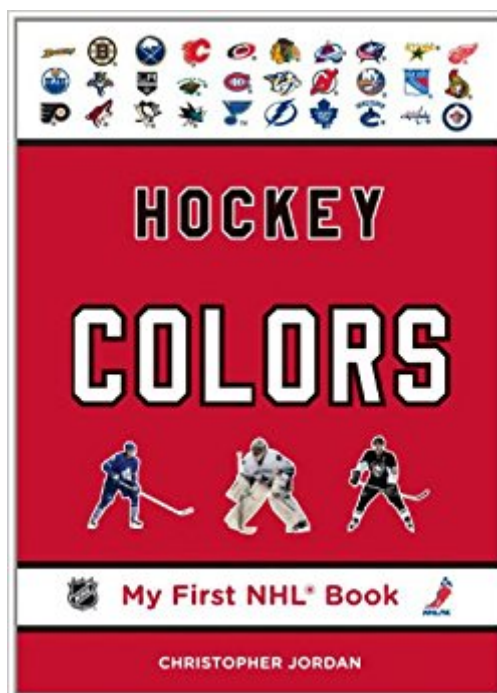

It wasn't long before his parents first put a hockey stick in his hands and his love for hockey began. A published children's book author and hopeful Leafs fan, Jordan is now introducing hockey to his own children with the hope of becoming an NHL dad someday. Residing in Toronto, Canada, Jordan and his wife Kim have three remarkable children, Stewart, Duncan, and Jacqeline. His published books include: The Little Beaver, Hockey ABC, Hockey 123, Hockey Shapes, and Hockey Colours.

I love reading this book to my (now 2 y.o.) daughter. It has helped her to learn her colors and she asks for this book at bedtime "hockey, daddy". It has a couple colors that can be confusing to a young child (yellow/gold and purple/burgundy), but I skipped them initially to avoid unnecessary confusion. Also, the page for "silver" has a gray background so I ask my daughter what color the Stanley Cup is (silver) and then follow up to ask what the background color is (gray) to make sure she doesn't consider gray to be silver too. Overall, I love this book and the entire series, and so does my daughter. If she loves it, it deserves 5 stars.

My brother and his wife are about to have their first baby and not only are they hockey fans, but they love to read so I thought this (and all the others in this collection) would be a wonderful addition to their reading time with baby. I looked through them all and love the pictures and text. The board books are very sturdy and I think they'll hold up to lots of drooling, chewing and slamming (I have 3 boys so I know how rough they can be with books). :)
