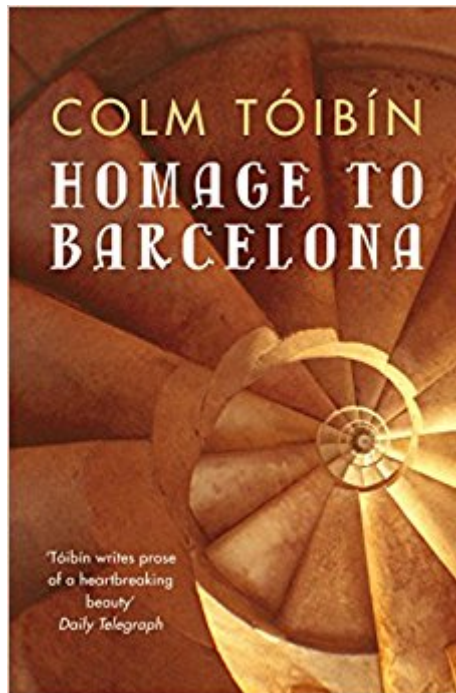




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Homage To Barcelona

It also explores the history of Catalan nationalism, the tragedy of the Civil War, the Franco years and the transition from dictatorship to democracy which Colm Toibin witnessed in the 1970s. His non-fiction includes *Bad Blood*, *Homage to Barcelona* and *The Sign of the Cross*. His work has been translated into seventeen languages. He lives in Dublin.
