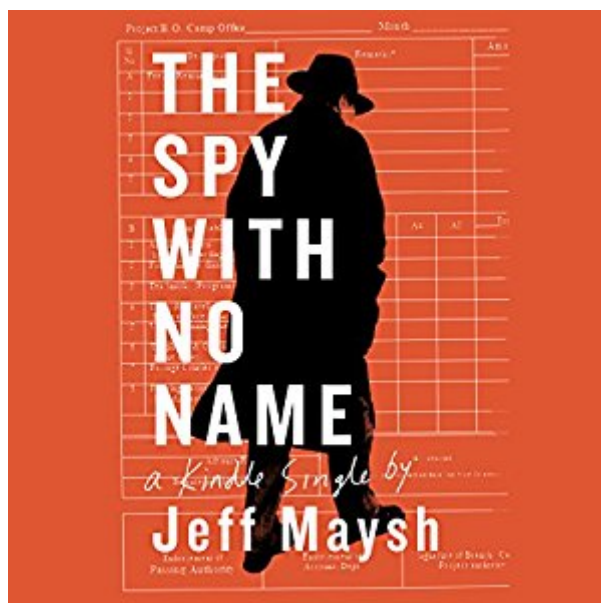

I have long been a fan of espionage books and movies. In this book we have a real life espionage story. Descriptions of the many techniques align well with the fictional books. This gives credit to both the real and fictional. This story is concise and short. The main character Erwin Van Haarlem is reasonably well developed. The mother Johanna does play a significant role as well. Most of the

other characters are not as thoroughly explained. Given that this is a historical description, it would have been much more difficult to get accurate information about these other characters. The many sources that are itemized gives stronger evidence to the accuracy of the story. However, I very much enjoyed this short story. I recommend this book especially to fans of espionage.

I found the story of Erwin van Haarlem's life as a spy to be quite interesting and informative. It's not every day you get to read about the life of a spy from recent history in this detail. This is a quick and entertaining read.
