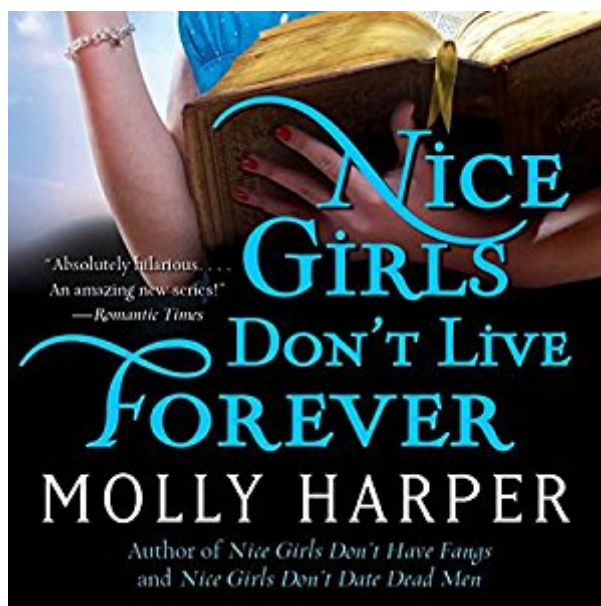


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Nice Girls Don't Live Forever: Half-Moon Hollow, Book 3
