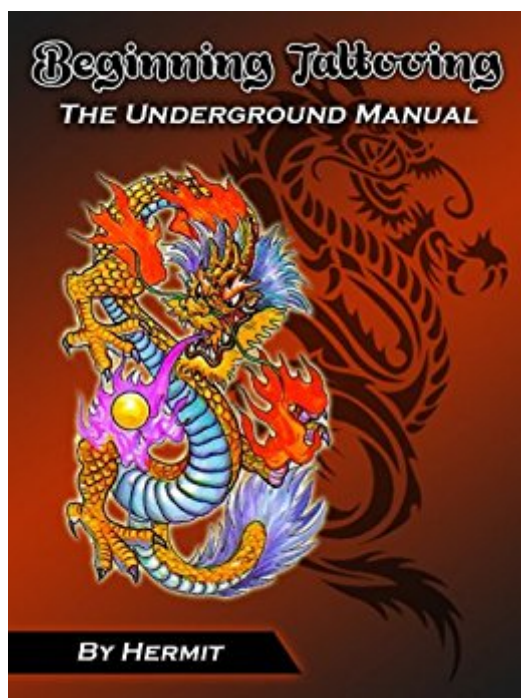

I did give it three stars because it could be a very useful book for the 'very' young beginners who are pretty clueless. I'm far, far, far from professional as I've never apprenticed and have only tattooed myself, my mother (ex-nun & accidental coke shorter.. long story but awesome lady) and one paying customer but as inexperienced as I am, I found very little useful information. All the information contained in this book would readily be available via a quick internet search of "How to tattoo". My biggest complaint (if only there were truly useful info. in the book) would be that the ebook has no linked table of contents for quick navigation.. though considering the lack of useful information, this doesn't much hamper the reader. In short, save your money and rely instead on internet searches.
