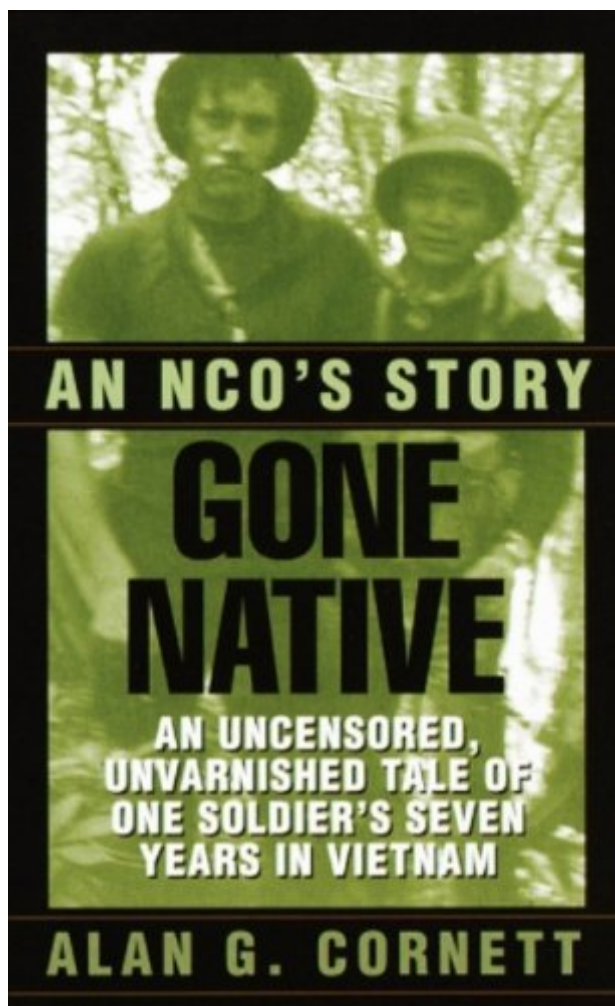

Gone Native: An NCO's Story

This is an above-average account of one soldier's experiences in Vietnam for seven years, much of it in combat and out in the bush on special operations. The author is brave and stubborn, but I also perceive him as a troubled soul, anti-authority and a somewhat questionable team player. He operated deep in enemy territory, and set up captures of high-ranking officers and ambushes. He knew if he made an error in judgement or movement, especially wearing the enemy's uniform, that the slightest mistake meant instant death. In this tome, he talked about his sexual exploits, smoking dope and being involved in fragging. He was more than a maverick - and his independent actions could affect others in tragic ways. Being the leader, would I want him on my team? I would have to think long and hard, but if I needed a 'special guy' for a special, delicate operation, Cornett would get my vote.
