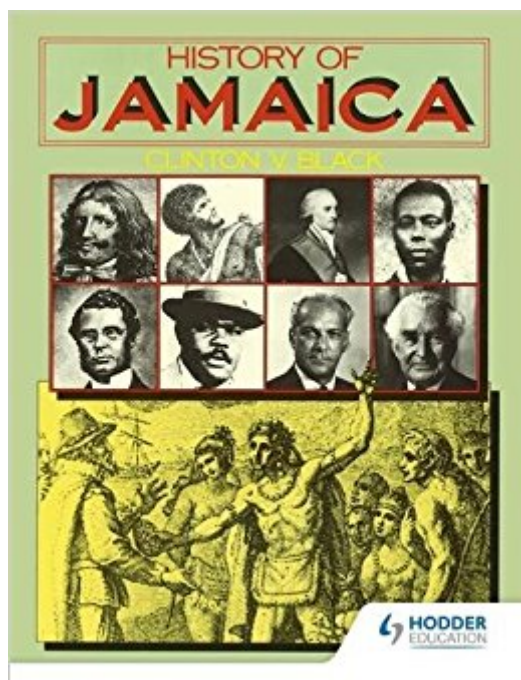

Clinton V. Black, a Jamaican, is the island's Government Archivist. His writing has ranged widely in scope and form, from the short story to purely professional archival works.

The author has written a brief, comprehensive history of an island which has seen many exciting events. Warfare, rebellion and the fight against slavery marked the early centuries. This makes for interesting reading, but many people living through it must have thought they were suffering the Chinese curse of living in "interesting times." The author continues the story through the struggle for independence and into modern times. This book provides an excellent starting point for the study of Jamaican history.
