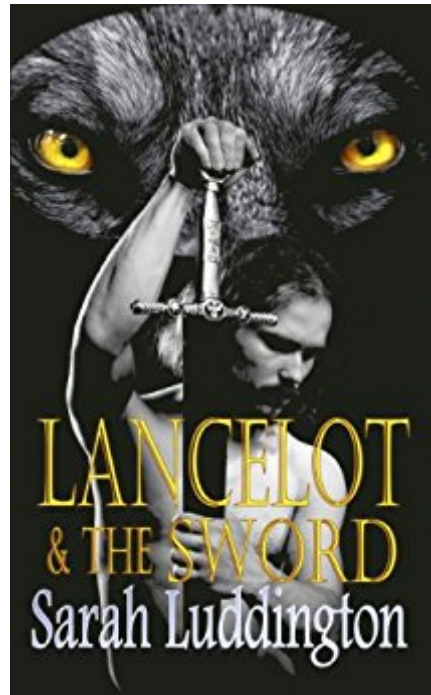


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Lancelot And The Sword (The Knights Of Camelot Book 2)

The second novel in Luddington's Lancelot series is an even stronger story than the first book, which was already excellent. Everything I liked about the first book, the action, the character development, the passionate relationships, all that is back, but bigger, deeper, richer. New plot developments send Arthur, Lancelot and Guinevere on a quest to defend Camelot against sinister new enemies. Complicated relationships explode, implode, come back together and then develop in new and unexpected ways. New characters like Tancred grabbed my interest as much as old favorites like Arthur. Familiar characters are given new elements that enrich them without taking away from their history. Luddington's Lancelot is a man of great passions, who loves too much but not well. His ability to love so greatly while also being incredibly destructive and dangerous made me think of the anti hero Lestat in the early Vampire Chronicles, which I consider the highest praise.

After reading the first book in this series I immediately purchased the second and was not disappointed. It increased the intensity of the first novel and the characters were all well developed. Lancelot and Arthur's relationship is painful to see and Lancelot struggles with his own feelings of guilt and wanting to protect his king. The action in the novel keeps you captivated and the introduction of new characters keeps you wanting more. I was surprised about the turn of events of another character introduced in the book but I enjoyed it. The ending is definitely a tearjerker... This is the stuff that keeps a reader coming back for more.

I loved all the characters especially Lancelot, he was long suffering and loved too hard and too much. King Arthur was a selfish prick. It was great reading, I enjoyed it.

I think this book was my favorite of the series. You leave this book feeling hopeful for Lancelot, that he will find love and feel free to pursue it despite the fact that he was raised to believe it was wrong to love a man. Like the first, the book is plagued with editing errors and the writing is not always polished. The value is in the story, and the development of the character of Lancelot, who does not lose his masculinity by loving other men. Other characters are less full and less appealing.

I'm not a very emotional person normally, but this book made me feel happy, sad, angry, and totally in love. I am head over heels in love with Lancelot. He is an amazing man who suffers through far more than one person should ever have to go through. This is the first book that had me so heart broken I cried, but it is very much worth the tears.
