Katja Spitzer has created another bright and colorful book for very young readers. This time we are taken outside and each double-spread shows us something different. From flowers and toadstools to hedgehogs and snowmen, outdoor scenes from throughout the year are shown in vivid detail. Whether it is the leaves from different trees or the variety of insects with their wings and legs, we see how much there is to discover right outside our own front doors. The final scene transitions from spring to winter as our eyes travel from left to right and we see many of the items from the previous pages. A bright, fun book for young readers who can use the picture clues to decode the word or phrase for each illustration. The small size also makes it easy for little hands to hold or carry.
