

As comfortable writing period stories as she is penning contemporary works, Lori's books (more than 6 million in print) vary widely in location and time period. Dakota Rawlings is the middle of the Rawlings brothers. Almost losing his life in a shootout caused him to evaluate his spiritual condition. Yielding his life to the Lord was the best thing that Dakota has

ever done. Recovering from his gunshot wounds has been the hardest. When Dakota is asked to escort his boss's niece to her friends house Dakota agrees. Darvi Wingate is determined to get to her friend to share her news. Darvi has finally seen her need for the Lord and she cannot wait to share with the friend that has prayed for her for years. After a wonderful visit with her friend and much needed rest for Dakota he continues to escort Darvi to the train headed for home. Dakota sees a woman that looks like Darvi being led away from the train, but when he follows he can't find the men or the woman so he lets it go. But his spirit is not at rest and after a couple of days with his brother Dakota decides to go back to Aurora and look into what he saw. Trouble seems to follow Darvi around and Dakota is right to go back and check on her. Darvi has been held against her will by a man and his family. The moment he set eyes on Darvi he had to have her. No matter how many times Darvi tells him that she will never care for him, he is determined to try and win her over. I love Dakota and Darvi's salvation experiences. I love their desire to grow in their relationship with Christ. Both are determined to find answers and live their lives serving Him and most of all to see their parents come to Christ as well. Darvi's abduction experience covers most of the book and the reader even feels a little bit of pity for the man that has been so taken with her. But no matter how nice of a man he seems to be what he has done is wrong and there is no getting around that. As with all of Lori Wick's books, the characters are sweet and likable. The spiritual lessons that the characters learn are woven into their stories and grow them in faith. I really enjoyed this story.

The story was interesting in the beginning. An injured Texas Ranger is assisting a young woman to her family. But then she's kidnapped and held captive until he figures out she's been taken and rescues her. Up to that point, I thought the story was great. I couldn't really see much chemistry between the two. Aside from one kiss during the story, I didn't feel like they were attracted to each other. Another thing that bothered me is how Lori Wick would introduce people into the story and let them have total personal conversations that didn't add to the story. She's got a habit of doing this, and normally it doesn't bother me. But it did this time. There was one couple they stopped to visit (her friend, I think) and there was a scene of the couple in bed when she announced she was pregnant. Why? What did that have to do with the story? Then there was the whole private conversation between her kidnapper and his girlfriend. After she was rescued, their stories were dropped - sort of disappointing. The ending was a BIG disappointment. There was no talk of marriage. In fact, Dakota went back to his ranger job, and she was living with her uncle... What's up with that???

I really like this book, you do need to have all 3 books before you start reading since you will want to just keep reading when you start.

Dakota stars in this sequel. I love how the author focused on what happens to him and how he ends up falling in love. Good use of your time.
