

The short book, packed with photographs from the times, is a helpful introduction to the German ideology, planning, and implementation of the murder of the Jews. It is fair and based on good research. The primary sources, such as a short letter from Goebbels that makes the point perfectly, are a good way to introduce the subject in college courses. There are review questions at the end of each chapter that foster discussion. It is recommended as a brief but powerful introductory survey.

What a superb book that deals with such a difficult topic. As a teacher I highly recommend this selection to all who are studying or researching the Holocaust or World War II. After each chapter you will find a short review as well as issues for students to discuss or contemplate. This is a must for all history teachers!
